26” DUEL: JACK DEFENDS, CHARLIE ATTACKS

Jack champion if 1st or 2nd - *Very high prob.*
Current WChamp. 26 WC wins, 36 podiums (46 starts), 6x WC Champ.

Charlie champion if 1st and Jack 3rd or worse - *Medium probability.*
20”: 3 WC podiums. 26”: 5 WC podiums, 2 wins, 1 WC Champ.

Baron podium = overall podium - *High prob.*
18 WC starts, 12 finals, 8 podiums, 1 win, 2nd overall ‘24.

Julen podium = overall podium - *High prob.*
20 starts, 11 finals, 7 podiums, 1 WC win and, 1 WC champion ‘21

Oliver podium if 2nd (Jack/Charlie win) or 3rd (Baron not 4th) - *Med/low prob.*
Debut 2023 (bronze Myrkdalen WC). 12 starts, 5 finals, 2 WC podiums.

Marti podium if 2nd (Jack/Charlie win) or 3rd (Baron not 4th) - *Med/low prob.*
‘24 back from ACL injury. 15 starts, 9 finals, 3 WC podiums.

CAN ANYONE STOP ALEJANDRO?

Alejandro champ if 1st/2nd - *Very high prob.*
Current WChamp. 3 WC Champ. 29 starts, 23 finals, 19 podiums, 10 WC wins.

Robin champ if 1st & Alejandro 3rd – *Med prob.*
2024 elite debut; 12 starts, 4 finals, and 3 WC podiums.

Palau champ if wins & Alejandro 4th. Overall podium if podium + ahead of Conejos – *med prob.*
He has 32 starts, 12 finals, 6 podiums, and 1 WC win.

Conejos champ if wins & Alejandro 4th. Overall podium if podium + ahead of Palau – *high prob.* .
29 starts, 16 finals, 11 podiums, and 5 WC wins. 3x WC Champion.

Thomas podium if 2 places ahead of Palau & Conejos – *Very low prob.*
43 starts, 27 finals, 7 podiums, 1 WC win.

TWO SPANIARDS, ONE CROWN

Alba champion if wins – *High prob*
Current WChamp. Debut 2023, 8 starts, 8 finals, 8 podiums, 2 WC wins.

Vera champion if wins – *Very high prob*
15 starts, 15 finals, 14 medals, 10 WC wins. 4x WC Champ.

Vabre 4th or better = 3rd overall - *Very high prob*
12 starts, 11 finals, 3 WC podiums.

Andrea 2 places ahead of Vabre + Reichenbach not winning = 3rd overall – *Low prob*
Debut 2023. 6 starts, 4 finals. 2x 4ths this year (behind Vabre).

Reichenbach must win, with Vabre 5th and Andrea 4th, to take 3rd overall - *Low prob*
16 WC wins, 32 podiums (36 starts). 4× WC Champ.
